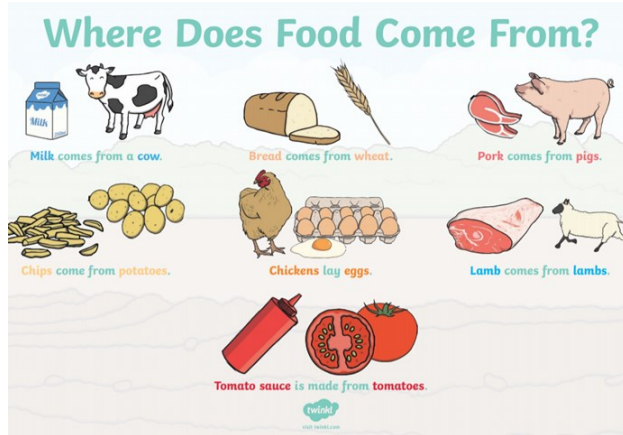

Key Vocabulary:

Landscape	A view of an area. What an area looks like.
Town	An area with streets, houses and buildings that is larger than a village but smaller than a city.
Pasture	A piece of land where animals graze.
United Kingdom	England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
Fresh food	Food that is not preserved or processed.
Local	Existing in or belonging to the area where you live.
Supermarket	A large shop selling foods and household goods.
