

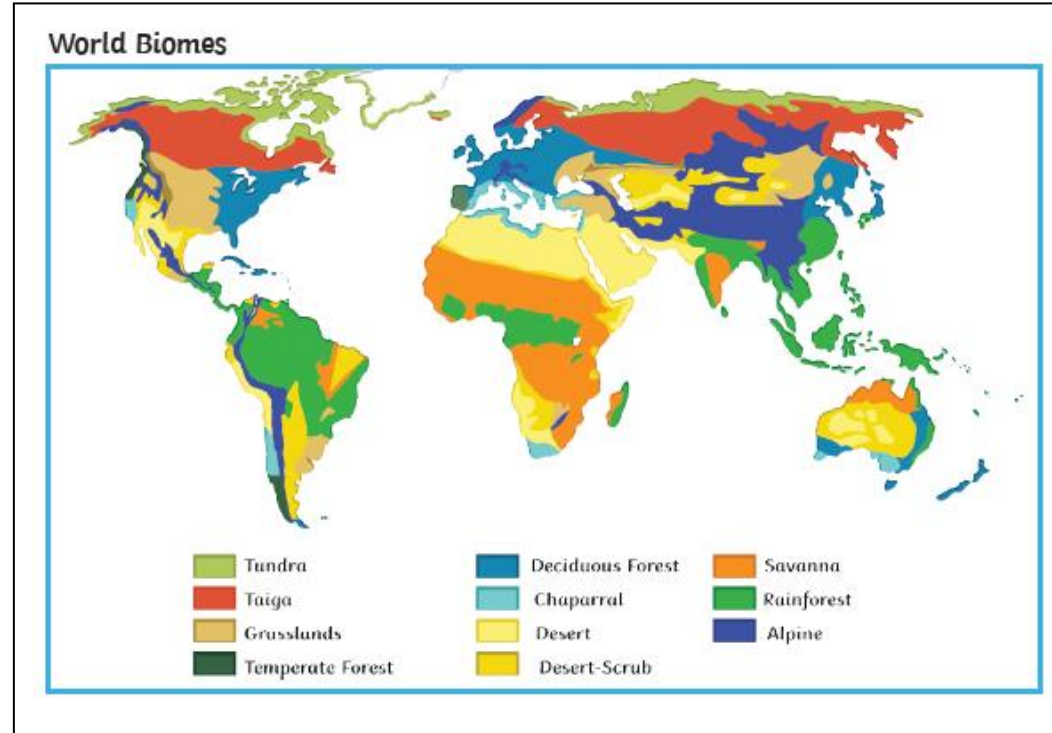
Geography – Climate and Weather

- Can identify multiple weather types

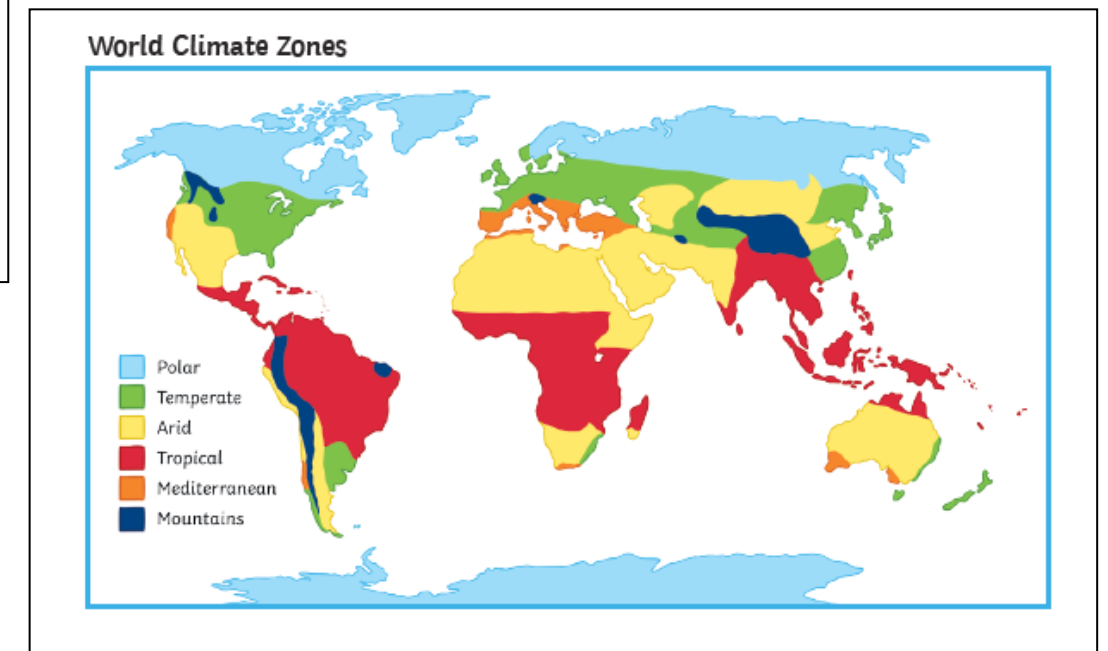
Key Vocabulary

climate	patterns of weather
biome	geographical area with similar climate
flora	plants native to an area, such as trees, climbers, flowers and grasses
fauna	animals native to an area, such as birds, reptiles and insects
season	period of time with similar weather
taiga	snowy forest
