

**What I should already know:**

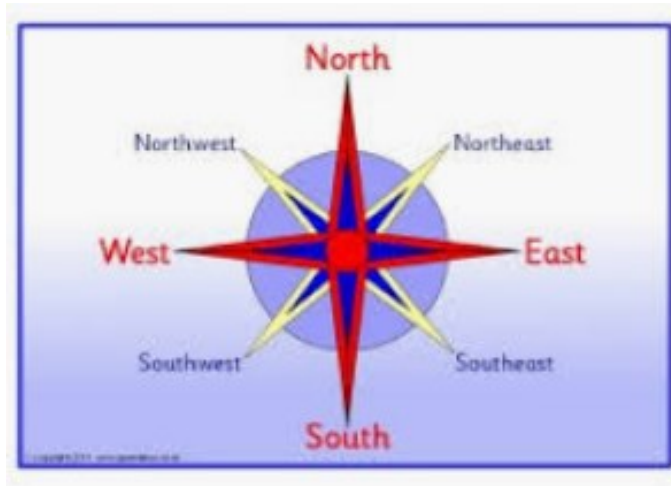
- ◆ Observe what changes across the 4 seasons.
